Having studied Medicine at KU Leuven between 1985 and 1992, Professor Evenepoel achieved his PhD in 1997, becoming Board Certified in Nephrology and assuming his current position in 2000. His research interests include the pharmacokinetics of protein-bound uraemic retention solutes, development and implementation of extracorporeal renal replacement therapies, gut-kidney axis, and CKD-MBD.</p>		
<p>Special awards or recognition: Within the ERA-EDTA, Pieter Evenepoel has been Ordinary Member of the Council (2014-2017), board member of the working group on Chronic Kidney Disease and Mineral Bone Disorders (ERA-EDTA CKD-MBD) (2014-2017) and is currently member of the Scientific Advisory Board (SAB) (2016-2018). Professor Evenepoel is a member of the European Renal Association-European Dialysis and Transplant Association (ERA-EDTA), American Society of Nephrology (ASN), the Belgian Society of Nephrology (BVN), the Dutch speaking-Belgian Society of Nephrology (NBVN), and the Kidney Disease Improving Global Outcomes (KDIGO) CKD-MBD working group, and is a fellow of the ERA. As well as contributing to over 225 publications in peer-reviewed journals and authoring chapters in books such as 'Comprehensive Clinical Nephrology', he is on the editorial board of Kidney International, and is CKD Theme Editor for Nephrology Dialysis Transplantation (NDT). Professor Evenepoel is also an ad hoc reviewer for a number of journals, including NDT, the Journal of the American Society of Nephrology (JASN), The Lancet, and the European Heart Journal.</p>
