<p>Key qualification(s) that will be of interest to attendees at this conference: Dr. Ozaltin is the founder of Nephrogenetics Laboratory at Hacettepe University, which is the first nephrogenetics laboratory in Turkey specifically dedicated for identification of underlying genetic abnormalities in hereditary kidney diseases in both children and adults. Dr. Ozaltin and his team have discovered 4 novel genes (i.e. PTPRO, DGKE, ANKS6, ADCK4) causing nephrotic syndrome when mutated primarily in his lab and have contributed significantly to discovery of other genes (i.e. PLCE1, MYO1E, OSGEP, TP53RK, TPRKB, and LAGE3, NUP93, NUP205, XPO5) in close collaboration with others. He has been involved 2 international projects (i.e. PodoNet (FP6-ERARE) and EURenOmics (FP7) as a project partner. He has 121 peer-reviewed publications and more than 6400 citations (h-index 35) and is currently involved several national and international projects. His current position is senior consultant, lecturer and researcher in pediatric nephrology at Hacettepe University.</p>
